SUBJECT: REPEAL: Non-Bank Owned ATM Registration

On June 30, 2017, Governor Rauner signed into law HB1783. The Electronic Fund Transfer Act (205 ILCS 616) was amended to repeal the requirement for all non-bank ATM owners to register terminals in Illinois with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Division of Banking. Effective immediately, non-bank ATM owners are no longer required to complete ATM registrations or annual registration renewals.
