## **RULES**

Board members reviewed and discussed incorporating the March 2, 2015 ASWB Model Regulatory Standards for Technology and Social Work Practice (ethics) into 68 IAC Section 1470.96.

Motion was made and seconded to recommend the current version be incorporated into the Rules. Motion carried.

The Board had a lengthy discussion about a shared concern about unlicensed activity occurring under the guise of getting one's supervision hours. The Board discussed requiring one to first be licensed as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker before he or she could become a Licensed Clinical Social Worker. Azeema Akram indicated that a change to the licensure requirements would require a legislative change. The Department does not run legislation of this sort. There was a question about whether the supervised hours could be completed as a volunteer. Neither the Act nor Rules prohibit the hours from being

Motion was made and seconded that the Board go on record as being concerned about protecting the public from unlicensed practice and interested in requiring LSW licensure as a requirement for LCSW licensure. Motion carried.

Board members discussed whether or not it would be valuable to have identified in Rules certain offenses on one's Criminal History Record that would be a bar to licensure as has been established for other professions.
